### IMPORTANT EXHIBITING NOTES

- New applicants are selected by a jury each season. The decision of the jurors is based on a scoring system to rate the work for technical skill, artistic expression and design. An artist must achieve an overall score of 80% for the work to be accepted.
- New applicants must submit at least five (5) photos of their work to the jury with their application. The photos should be representative of the work the artist intends to exhibit.
- Exhibiting artists must arrange to deliver their work to the gallery by the last date for set-up. Artists are encouraged to assist the Presentation Committee in setting up their displays. The Presentation Committee reserves the right to arrange the work in the gallery and also the right to reject any work which is not representative of the juried submissions.
- Art work should be gallery ready upon delivery.
- Artists are responsible for pricing their work. Each artist will be supplied with inventory sheets and price tags.
- Exhibiting artists pay a 35% commission on sale of their work. Artists who wish to volunteer are eligible for a 15% commission rate.

All exhibiting artists are required to sign and submit a full agreement outlining all instructions for exhibiting at the Loft. A copy of this can be found at [www.artintheloft.org](http://www.artintheloft.org) or upon request
